#### 2024/06 Playing Field & Pocket Park

Playing Field: Ground condition. Council noted that ground is uneven at the edges. Cllr RGn will arrange for cars to smooth the area at the car rally.

2024/1470/FULL at Brampton Heath Golf Centre Sandy Lane Church Brampton NN6 8AX (CO Nisa Mogul, obs. by 3 May) Brampton Heath Golf Centre Sandy Lane Church Brampton NN6 8AX

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Council OBJECT to the construction of this building. The building will be overly dominate in the rural, largely open landscape. It will detrimentally impact the adjacent footpath which is enjoyed by many in the area. The scale and design are wholly unsympathetic to the existing building as no matching materials have been included, and landscape as the building would not blend into the setting. The design specified would be better suited to an urban sports facility rather than a rural golf centre.

In addition, council is concerned that security lighting and other outdoor lighting will detrimentally impact residents on Golf House Lane.

Council notes the building makes no consideration for sustainability or carbon neutrality.

Council is aware that WNC have been asked if planning consent granted on land opposite the Church is still valid (original application DA/2009/0948).
